



Professor Dr. Thomas Druyen

Thomas Druyen is the founder of the European wealth research and wealth psychology. He studied law, sociology, journalism, and philology at the Wilhelms University in Münster and anthropology at the University of Colombo in Sri Lanka. From 2006 to 2010 he served as director of the Forum for Research on Wealthability at the Wilhelms University in Münster. In 2007 he was appointed ordinary professor of the Sciences of Comparative Wealth and Wealth Psychology at the Sigmund Freud Private University in Vienna and in 2009 became the director of the newly established institute of the same name. From 2005 to 2007 he also taught at the Institute for Culture and Media Management at the Freie Universität Berlin. He gained international recognition with his books *Olymp des Lebens – das neue Bild des Alters*, published in 2003, and *Goldkinder*, published in 2007, in which he analysed the world of the wealthible and their importance for society. Between 2000 and 2004 Druyen was a member of the Board of the Swiss Peter Ustinov Foundation. Since 2001 he has held the position of President of the Board of Curators of the Foundation Dialogue of Generations in Dusseldorf. From 2005 to 2010 he was also Chairman of the Board of Curators of the Stiftung Kloster Steinfeld. At the same time, Druyen served as a consultant or in senior positions in the area of corporate communications and culture at banks, institutions and foundations. He is a Member of the Advisory Board of the Görres Gesellschaft and a Member of the Board of the Liechtenstein Foundation.
